The Medical Coder/Biller program is designed to prepare students for employment in a variety of health care settings as entry-level coder, medical record coders, coding technician, or coding clerks, or medical coder/biller or SOC Cod 29-2071 (Medical Records and Health Information Technicians).

This program offers a sequence of courses that provides coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for further education and careers in the Health Science career cluster; provides technical skill proficiency, and includes competency-based applied learning that contributes to the academic knowledge, higher-order reasoning and problem-solving skills, work attitudes, general employability skills, technical skills, and occupation-specific skills, and knowledge of all aspects of Health Science career cluster.

Licensure/Certification

A certificate of completion is awarded to a student upon successful completion of all program requirements including satisfying the TABE requirement. The student is prepared to sit for the certification exam for Certified Professional Coder through the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC) and the fees for membership and exam costs are included in the cost of the program. Having this certification upon completion of a program enables the student to be uniquely prepared for employment.
