### **Program Description**

The Patient Care Assistant program is designed to prepare students for employment as cross-trained nursing assistants (SOC 31-1014 Nursing Assistant). All others; Patient Care Assistants, Nursing Aides and Orderlies, or Home Health Aides. This program offers a broad foundation of knowledge and skills, expanding the traditional role of the nursing assistant, for both acute and long term care settings.

The program focuses on broad, transferable skills and stresses understanding and demonstration of the following elements of the health care industry; planning, management, finance, technical and production skills, underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues and health, safety and environmental issues.

### **Licensure/Certification**

A certificate of completion is awarded to a student upon successful completion of all program requirements. In order to be eligible for hire, the student must pass the State Examination for Nursing Assistant and receive the designation of Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA).
